

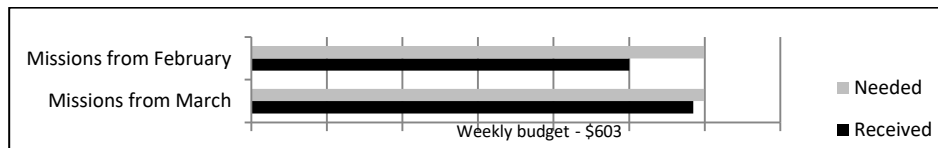
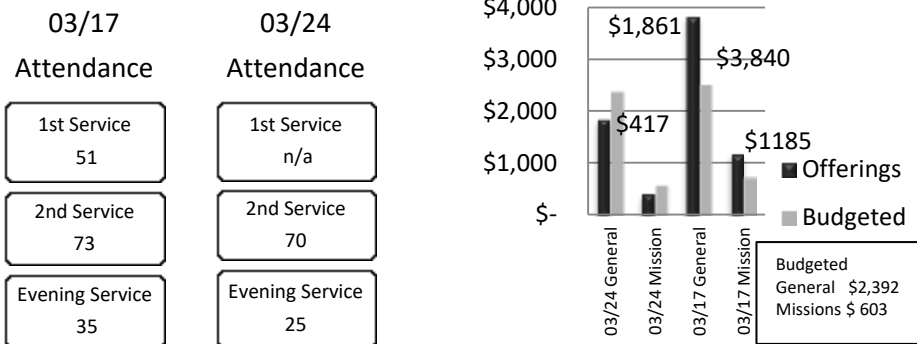
Glen & Marci Mongold - Foreign Merchant Seamen - Virginia
