

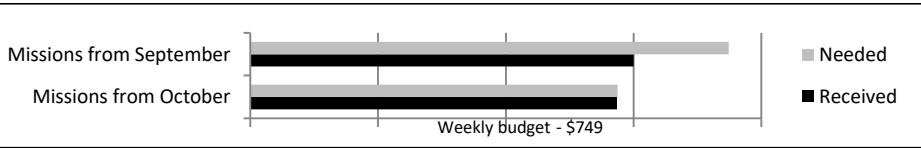
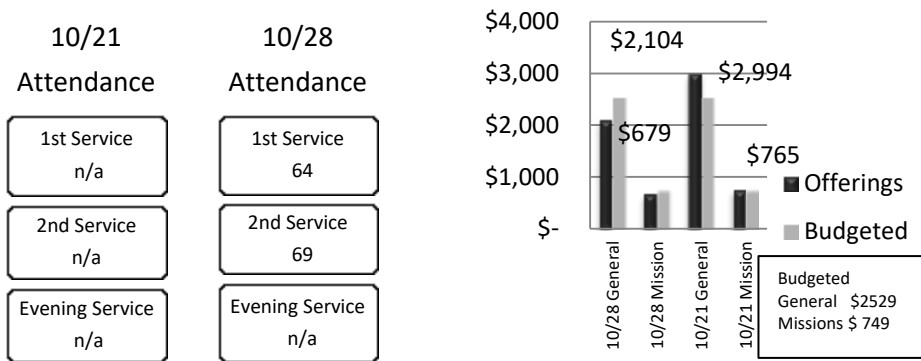
Sam & Belinda Flores - Independent Baptist Missions for Asians - Philippines
