

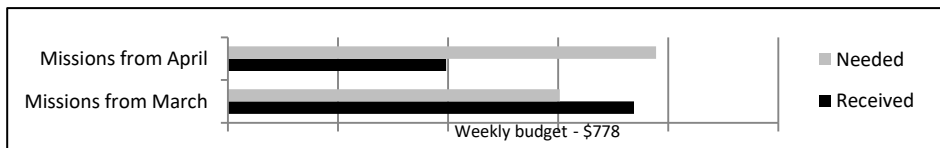
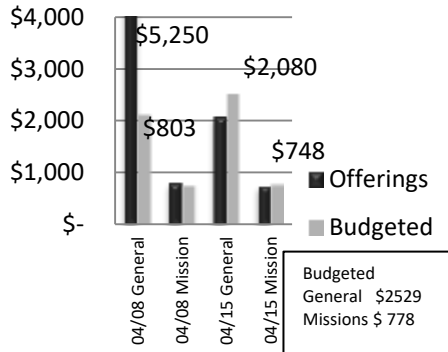
Wes & Faith-Ann Bartley - Baptist Intl. Missions, Inc. St. Lucia
