

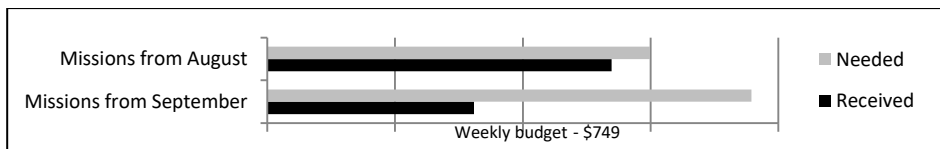
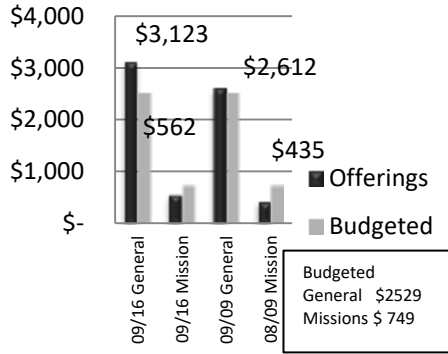

Many of you have heard of the brutal treatment of the Rohingya tribal people in northern Myanmar (Burma). As many as 700,000 or more have been forced to flee over the border into southern Bangladesh where they are "camping out" under tarps with little food or medical care. Thankfully several international organizations have sent personnel to help them. Our ABWE hospital is just 45 minutes from the border and many Rohingyas who have lost limbs and have been badly beaten have been taken there for surgery and medical help. Our son, Harold, and his wife, Shawn, have been responsible for much of the oversight and planning. Many of the hospital's Bengali medical helpers are able to speak the Rohingyas' language and are sharing the Gospel with them. This is the first time most of these persecuted people have heard of God's love for them. Pray that many of them will come to know the Savior!
